The following criteria will be used for judging the submission:

Displays leadership in the CHES BC Chapter.	10
Demonstrates achievements and/or impacts to a healthcare facility and/or organization in British Columbia.	35
Dedicates volunteer time for CHES special events such as the Trade Show and Education Forum and/or time serving a number of positions on committees, Chapter and/or National Boards.	10
Demonstrates results in a special project that showcases leadership in healthcare facilities and/or organizations for other members in British Columbia.	25
Displays eagerness and enthusiasm to improve and benefit the CHES BC Chapter and/or CHES National Organization.	20
