With over 28 years of progressive experience - including 20 years in the healthcare sector, Colin is a seasoned leader in infrastructure, facilities management, and capital planning. Currently serving as Senior Regional Director of Facilities and Support Services for Newfoundland and Labrador Health Services (NLHS) in the Eastern Urban and Rural Zones, Colin provides strategic leadership across a complex healthcare system, overseeing infrastructure operations, large-scale capital projects, and leasing programs that support safe, efficient, and innovative care delivery.

Throughout his career, Colin has demonstrated expertise in facilities management, engineering, project management, and business continuity.
